**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Sub : - Implementation of the Government's decision on the recommendations of the sixth Central Pay Commission– Revision of provisions regulating pension/ gratuity/ commutation of pension/ family pension etc.**

In pursuance of the approval of the Govt of Arunachal Pradesh, a copy of OM No. F. No. 38/37/08-P& PW (A) dated 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2008, issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Personnel Public Grievances and Pensions, Deptt of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare, New Delhi, on the above subject, which is also applicable to the pensioners /family pensioners of the Govt of Arunachal Pradesh is circulated to all concern for information and necessary action, subject to the following modifications: -

1. All the amendments /modification of the existing CCS (Pension) Rule – 1972, Commutation of Pension Rule, EOP Rule, Family Pension Rule etc. shall come into effect notionally w.e.f. 1.1.2006 and with financial benefit from 1.1.2009.
2. For those who retired or died during the period from 1.1.2006 to 31.12.2008, the pay will be revised notionally on the basis of the OM No. FIN/E –II/22/08 dated 5.1.2009 and pension /family pension will be recalculated which shall be payable in cash w.e.f. 01.01.2009.
3. Arrear of monthly pension / family pension and applicable DR thereon inclusive of Gratuity, commutation of pension and leave encashment for 6 (six) months for the period from July to December 2008, would be paid in cash in 2 (two) equal installments @ 3 (three) months each or part thereof in the financial year 2008 – 09 & 2009 – 10.

The Heads of Offices shall take immediate action to revise the pay of the employees served under them and forward the claim for revision of pension to the Director of Audit & Pension along with revised form – 7, ten months pay drawal statement, calculation sheet, LPC and updated service book of the incumbent concern, who in turn will issue the revised Pension Payment Order (PPO) to the concern Pension Disbursing Authorities.
